Standing orders for Technical Advisor to Chief Minister

Lt. Gen. G.S. Dhaliwal, who has been working as
Technical Advisor to Chief Minister, Punjab since 2008, shall perform
the following :-

- i) Act as an interface between various agencies involved with the development projects, State Government and the Union Government;
- ii) Add value to the projects at the conception, planning and execution stages advice on reports submitted by consultants on infrastructure and Engineering Projects;
- iii) Enhance integration and connectivity through infrastructure and technology initiatives;
- iv) Ensure that infrastructure development and its use, protects and where feasible enhances the environment, quality of life and health of the citizens. In addition reduce pollution (including noise) levels and bring in enhanced use of non-renewable resources thereby provide wider cost benefits to the society;
- v) Be responsible to ensure proper quality is maintained in all identified projects under execution;
- vi) Assist in ensuring all identified projects are completed with no time and cost over runs; and
- vii) Scrutinize the estimates prepared by the departments including Department of Irrigation, Power, Public Works, Water Supply and Sanitation, Punjab Mandi Board and Rural Development & Panchayats to ensure not only the estimates are prepared as per the technical code/instructions but also

these reflect fully on the ground situation of each of the project. This scrutiny should be carried out before a project or scheme is bid out. It shall be incumbent on the concerned department to ensure that all contracts are awarded as per the estimates approved or cleared by the Technical Advisor. In case, any department has a different opinion, the Department of Public Works shall set up a committee of 3 Chief Engineers including Chief Engineer of the concerned department to explain position to the Technical Advisor and thereafter the agreed project/scheme should be prepared and finalized. The cases of difference of opinion shall be put up to CM through CS.

2.0 The concerned Administrative Departments shall extend necessary assistance to Lt. Gen. G.S. Dhaliwal in this regard.

3.0 CS may advise all concerned departments accordingly.
